Punctuation Power Signs:

- **Period (.)** → Ends a telling sentence (statement).
- **Question Mark (?)** → Ends an asking sentence.
- **Exclamation Point (!)** → Shows strong feeling or excitement!
- **Comma (,)** → Takes a pause between list items or in dates.
